Conclusions

- Genesis 2 does not harmonize with Genesis
 The Bible is giving a second story that is not entirely compatible with the first.
- This is very relational. There appears to be a community of characters that include humans, God, the ground, animals.
- 3. God allows others to be part of the creative, notably people.
- If people are being delegated with creation responsibilities, creation must not be finished.
- 5. God honors human input on the creative process.
- 6. God makes mistakes.
- 7. Both God and man evaluate their work.

- 8. God doesn't renege on allowing people crucial responsibilities.
- The responsibility for creating most humans begins with God and then passes to people themselves.
